


Abortions Continue During Pandemic

A study released in mid-May by COVIDSurg Collaborative has projected that nearly 400,000 elective surgeries across Canada, including cancer surgeries, will have been cancelled or delayed by mid-June due to the coronavirus, leading to unnecessary deaths, deteriorating health and a huge backlog of people waiting for their operations. And yet, abortions in Canada have continued unimpeded.

On March 26, CTV News reported that all ten Canadian provinces and three territories, when asked about abortion access during COVID-19, responded that despite placing restrictions on elective surgeries, abortions were being carried out regardless. Abortion has been consuming critical resources such as masks, gloves and protective gear.

Pregnant women worried about the virus can be encouraged by data so far that indicates they do not appear to be at higher risk of COVID-19 compared to non-pregnant adults. Also, mother-to-child transmission of the coronavirus during pregnancy is unlikely.

Abortion and Euthanasia Statistics

- 42,853 unborn babies were aborted in Ontario over a one year period from 2017 to 2018. That's a staggering number, but is 6% less than three years ago. These numbers are based on OHIP billings and considered accurate.
- There have been more than 13,500 euthanasia deaths in Canada from the time it became legal in June 2016 until December 31, 2019. More than 5,400 of those occured in 2019 alone.

Sex Selective Abortion Act

MP Cathay Wagantall has introduced a Private Members Bill to ban sex selection abortion. Bill C-233 would create a new penalty for medical practitioners who knowingly perform an abortion when the sole reason is the genetic sex of the pre-born child.

"In a country which seeks to foster equality between men and women, using abortion for sex selection needs to be prohibited," said Wagantall. "Eighty-four percent of Canadians are against sex selective abortion." Wagantall says the Canadian Medical Association has come out saying sex selection abortion is a growing problem in Canada.
